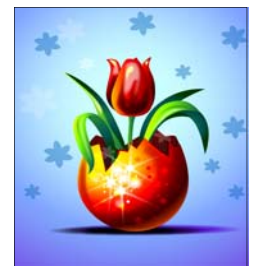

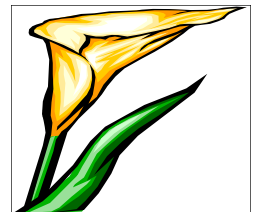

A Thank You From The House Committee



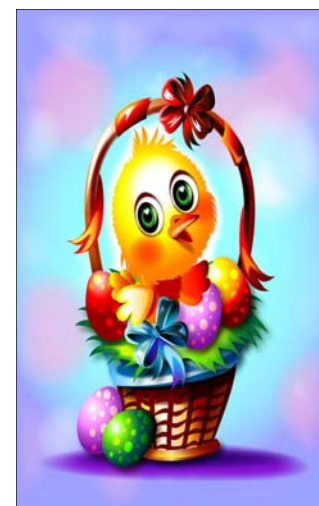
